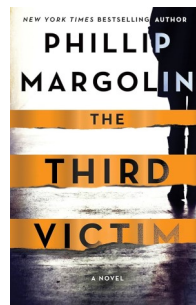
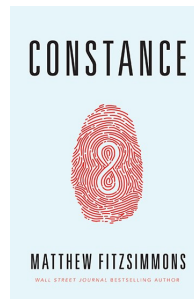

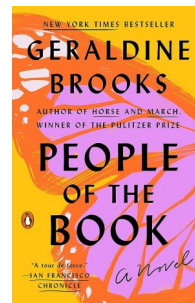

Book drops will be locked to prevent overfilling.

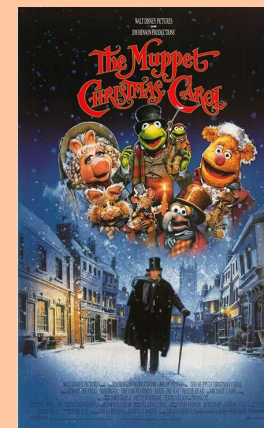
